They plan, design, apply and evaluate solutions to unpredictable problems, and identify, analyse and synthesise information from a variety of sources.

Students who complete this course will typically be able to perform leadership and management job roles in Business services and other industries and they would have full responsibility and accountability for the personal output and work of others e.g. department manager or unit manager.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

DELIVERY MODES

The course is delivered face-to-face in classrooms with access to computers, printers, accounting software and access to all the equipment and resources identified in each unit of competency.

Self-Paced Learning: Students also complete independent self-paced learning each week, comprising of research, additional readings, assignments, projects and preparing for assessments (10 hours per week for 40 weeks, amounting to 400 hours). All units are delivered as a stand-alone unit.
